

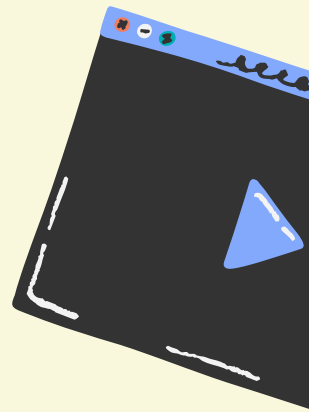

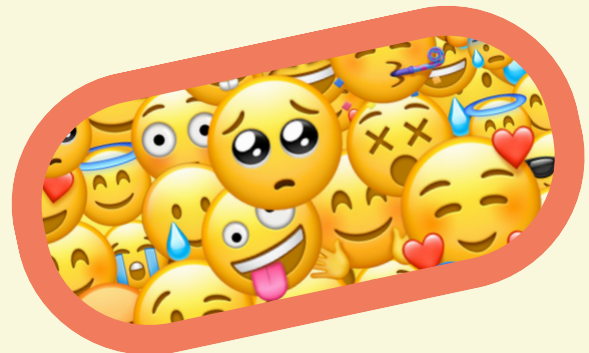

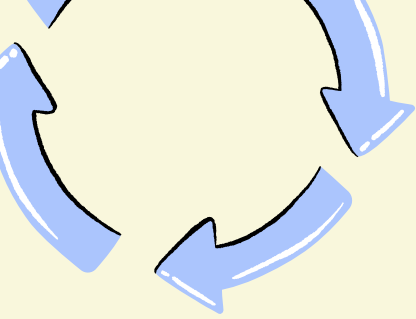
In memory of Giuliano Morasco

The Therapy Theatre Seminar

will offer two days of workshops in different groups. Language skills or the ability to speak English are not necessary – the focus will be nonverbal.

Participation is open for clients and staff members.

Following tradition, the meeting will conclude with a public performance showcasing the final outcomes of the workshops, possibly also including performances prepared beforehand by participants. The topic highlights the impact of social media, virtual reality, and connected addiction dynamics on the lives of adolescents and adults.
