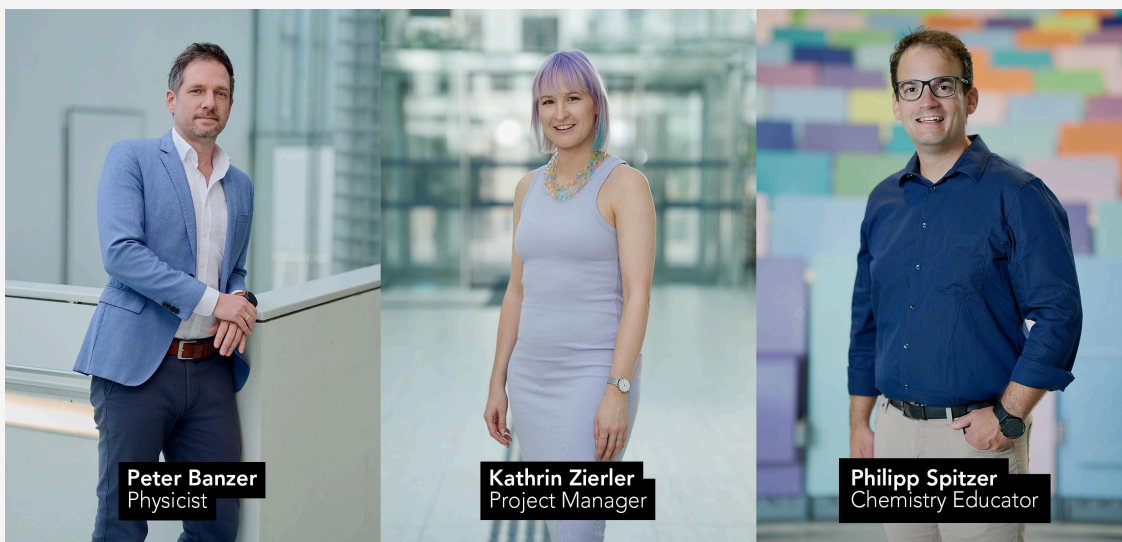

Job Description

According to the governmental statutes for psychotherapy (Psychotherapiegesetz: PthG 2024), master's degree programmes in Psychotherapy will be introduced at Austrian universities. The University of Graz offers a professorship for Child and Adolescent Psychotherapy. The position will be based at the newly founded Graz Centre for Psychotherapy. The professorship will be responsible for research and teaching in this area.

- Outstanding academic qualifications in research and teaching in the relevant discipline and for the profile of the professorship (commensurate with stage of academic career and interruptions in employment due to caring responsibilities)

- Professional experience abroad during academic career
- Management and leadership experience
